
BRAND LOGOS



BERNARDINE EVARISTO

AWARD-WINNING BRITISH AUTHOR





Bestselling British writer **Bernardine Evaristo** is the celebrated author of eight books and numerous other works that span the genres of verse fiction, short fiction, poetry, essays, literary criticism, journalism, and radio and theatre drama. In 2019, she became the first black woman to win the Booker Prize for her newest book, *Girl, Woman, Other.* The novel was also one of Barack Obama's 19 Favorite Books of 2019. Evaristo's writing is characterized by experimentation, daring and subverting the myths of various Afro-diasporic histories and identities, and her books range in genre from poetry to short story to drama to criticism.
